WORSHIP

This Weekend, we welcome Supt. Pam Braman as our guest speaker. Pam will round out our series of guest pastors we've invited to the pulpit since last September, as we awaited an interim pastor. We are so grateful to each pastor who has shared with us during this time of transition and pray God's blessing on their future preaching ministry as they serve area congregations.

Welcome, Pastor Glenn & Nancy! Our interim pastor, Glenn Teal, and his wife, Nancy, will be joining us for worship this weekend! Following worship services, you're invited to a welcome reception in the Family Life Center. Pastor Glenn officially begins his ministry here on Monday, January 20, and will begin preaching in services January 25 & 26.
