WORSHIP

Back in the third week of March, when COVID19 hit hard, we decided not to meet for worship in person. However, we had a service all prepared as a celebration of The Celtic Way. Since this Sunday will be our first chance to worship again in person, we decided to revisit our original Celtic theme. **Timeless themes like Worshiping the Trinity, Entering the Quiet, and Experiencing Everyday Spirituality will be combined with beautiful Celtic Music to create an overall worship experience designed to inspire your faith. Join us this Sunday at 10:30am on <u>Facebook</u> and <u>YouTube</u>.**

If you haven't registered to join us for our first In-Person Worship Service this Sunday, there's still time! To make sure we can safely accommodate everyone, we ask that you register on our website each week for the coming Sunday's service or you can call the church office. (Even staff members and those serving as volunteers need to register every week.) As excited as we are to see everyone, we do understand that not everyone will be ready to meet back in the building, and that is OK. We'll continue to offer online worship services on Facebook and YouTube.

Following federal and state guidelines and guidance from the CDC, we have created a <u>Regathering Safety Plan</u> to facilitate reopening for in-person worship—we encourage you to <u>read through the entire safety plan</u>. These guidelines will be re-evaluated on a regular basis and updated as needed. It's our hope that these guidelines are "for now," not forever. If it rains, after the service we'll settle Pastor Glenn and his family under a canopy while everyone lines up in a car parade to say farewell. You can enjoy your lunch while you wait in your car.

- This event was rained out last Tuesday so it's rescheduled for **August 11: TNT 6:30-8 pm at Black Creek Park** (3835 Union Street, North Chili, New York 14514). Hang out with friends; play bocce, whiffle ball, impromptu frisbee golf, or other games, and take a walk in the park or fish for bass and panfish (fishing tackle and bait will be provided, or bring your own—NYS fishing license is necessary for those age 16 and up). As we move back to in-person worship services and continue to live stream our services every Sunday, there are many opportunities available (both digital and in-person).

- Our **Guest Services Team** responsibilities have changed a bit due to COVID guidelines. Each Sunday, we need about nine energetic and welcoming people serving as greeters, check-in helpers, and ushers. Training is provided. The goal is for each team member to serve one Sunday per month, arriving by 9:45 and staying through the end of the service.
