THANKSGIVING COMMUNITY FOOD MINISTRY

Our Thanksgiving Community Food Ministry is in full swing! We are asking everyone to participate in Adopt-a-Boxes again this year, but with a plea to donate 1,2, or even 3 boxes per family to provide for the extra need. Boxes (about the size of a copy paper box) are available at the church, if you need one. We've set aside several special donation dropoff weekends to help spread them out a bit. NEXT WEEKEND, OCTOBER 24 & 25, is a drop-off weekend. Bring Adopt-a-Boxes into the church and leave them at the wall across from the Family Life Center (by the Orchard Street entrance). If you miss the donation drop-off day, you can leave your donation at the church before/after any weekend service or weekdays from 6:30am-6pm.
