WORSHIP

This weekend will be a Service of Thanksgiving and Praise. If you plan to join us in-person, we ask that you <u>register</u> <u>ahead of time</u>—be sure you click through until you receive a confirmation email. Or, you can call the church office at 585-594-9488. We also continue to Livestream our Sunday worship service on <u>Facebook</u> and <u>YouTube</u> at 10:30am.

Next weekend is the first weekend of Advent. Holy Communion will be served in worship services and following our tradition, an Exit Offering will be received. This month's Exit Offering will go to the village of Nzige, Rwanda to help them meet government regulations by building new classrooms for their school. The new classrooms will help keep older kids in school longer and will allow classes to spread out more due to COVID.

Just a reminder that our **Wednesday night** <u>Weekly Connect times on Facebook</u> have come to an end. In the coming week, we encourage you to take time to thank the Lord for all He has done in your life and the life of our church this year. Then, as we move into the Advent season, we'll focus as a church on Advent Conspiracy. You'll hear more later this month, but you can visit the Advent Conspiracy website now to learn what AC is all about and find ways to celebrate Christmas differently this year, https://adventconspiracy.org/worship-fully/. You'll find a link to 25 daily Advent devotionals and several activities are listed that emphasize worship. Consider choosing one activity each week of Advent that will help put the focus on worship instead of the busyness of the season. Yes, we will celebrate Christmas Eve this year! We need to run things a little differently, but we will still hold services. We'll offer three in-person Christmas Eve Services in the Sanctuary at 4pm*, 6pm*, and 8pm (*childcare available for infants-age 4). Plus, we'll post a special pre-recorded Christmas Eve Service on YouTube and Facebook that night at the same times for those who can't make it to the church. Pre-registration for in-person services opens on December 1 and will be required for everyone attending.
