WORSHIP

This weekend, James Weise will be preaching on the “God’s Surprises” series as he shares the message “Jesus Slept” from Mark 4:35-41. We will also be welcoming Gary Bauch into membership.

Journey Kids (birth-5th grade): Nursery care (birth-Pre-Kindergarten) is provided during the Saturday evening service. On Sunday morning, nursery care (birth up to age 2) is provided and Sunday School is offered for kids (age 2 years-5th grade) during the service.
