- **Sunday Discipleship Hour**: Classes begin Sunday, September 19 from 9-10am. A list of class options will be available at worship services this weekend, and online soon. Be sure to check out these great options for the whole family!
- Community Bible Study (CBS): The class is open to women and children (up to age 11). The study includes Daniel, 1&2 Timothy, Titus, and James. This in-person Wednesday morning class meets from 10:30am-12:30pm. Online options are also available on Wednesday morning and evening. #### Pearce Teens:

 Wednesday Night Youth Group (WNYG) is a once a week gathering where teens (6-12<sup>th</sup> grade) regroup, recalibrate, and recharge spiritually that also provides a fun, enjoyable, and welcoming atmosphere for teens (regardless of where they are at in their spiritual journey) to grow in community and friendship. Our teens come together as a big family to hang out, eat, have fun, worship, be mentored, and grow in their faith (MS and HS will be separate for small group discussion). This time helps teens to refocus themselves on embracing God's mission for them in what appears to be seemingly ordinary life. **Youth Group meets regularly on Wednesdays from (6:30-8pm)**. We will **start and end our time in the gym/café**.

- The first of many **Sunday Morning "Teen Talks"** will be on **September 19 at 9am** and meet in the main teen area in the Loft (upstairs), and after announcements break up into a middle school group and a high school group. **Teen Talks** are an informal and collaborative time for teens that includes opportunities to share and grow in their understanding of the essentials of the Christian faith, while also allowing space for teens to grapple with questions. It's a time for teens to go deeper in their understanding of the basics of the Bible, the story of God, and how to interpret scripture. This time on Sunday mornings also provides teens the opportunity to discern how their faith intersects with the relevant issues of our day. **Middle School Teen Talks** (6-8<sup>th</sup> grade) focuses on the essentials of faith whereas **High School Teen Talks** (9-12<sup>th</sup>) delves deeper into Biblical interpretation, the creeds, and Christian issues.

Enjoy competition but in a fun and supportive environment? 6-12th graders are invited to join the **Bible Quiz** team. Practices are held on Tuesday nights from 7-8:30 in the teen area with tournaments once a month on Saturday from October through April. Join us as we study Hebrews, I and 2 Peter and Jude. Practices include study time, jumping practice, and a devotion and prayer time.
