Plan Ahead

- Adult Discipleship Spring Course Options:
 - The Book of Ephesians gives us Paul's understanding of God's ultimate plan for his creation. Jesus' prayer for love and unity (John 17:20-23) is unpacked in this letter as Paul discusses the importance of God's love within us as the foundation for true unity in the church and world. He concludes his letter with a call to live a life worthy of the calling we have received. With teaching and opportunity for discussion, Dave Carden will guide the group through this Pauline letter. This course will begin on Sunday, April 16 and run for 6 weeks from 10:45 11:45am. Go here to register for this course.
 - <u>The Love Required of Us</u>, a biblically based study by Liz Cornell, will begin on April 16 and run for 8 weeks on Sundays from 10:45am – 12pm. We are all impacted by race. Led by Jess Newcomb and Megan Hoose, the purpose of this course is to guide groups of people, regardless of racial makeup, in discussions of race and racial restoration within a Christian context.
