Letter From Mike Wilson, Official Board Chair

Friday, June 2, 2023

Greetings Pearce Church,

Twenty-two years ago, our church purchased the property at 49 Orchard Street to serve as a respite for missionaries returning from the field. Over those years, many families made this house their home while they reconnected with friends and family. It gave them a place to refuel before heading back to the field. Pearce's Mission House Support Team invested their time and resources in caring for this space as a ministry to the missionaries.

In the last several years, we have experienced a change with fewer missionaries taking extended sabbaticals. Additionally, several who have utilized this space have concluded their service on the mission field. The occupancy rate by missionaries has averaged 26% over the last five years. Even with occasional use by others, the house has been vacant more than 50% of the time.

The Board established a task force to look further into the Mission House's use related to the mission and vision of the church. They received input from the Great Commission Leadership team (GCLT), missionaries who have used the house, and long-time supporters of the home. They also reviewed the costs of owning the home, which has averaged \$8,000 per year in maintenance and improvements. More expensive upkeep needs are anticipated in the next few years. The GCLT expressed that there are other priorities more aligned with Pearce's mission. In consideration of all these factors, the task force has recommended that Pearce sell the house.

The Board reviewed the task force recommendation and approved the sale of the house. The next step is a review and vote by the Society (Full Members). Your presence is requested to further discuss this proposal on Sunday, June 18 following the worship service. You will have an opportunity to hear more about this plan, ask questions, and vote on the path forward.

Please be reassured that Pearce will continue to support our missionaries financially and through prayers and will welcome them and assist them as we can during their home visits. Feel free to contact me or one of the Official Board members if you have any questions.
