- **Home Alone Class** – sponsored by P4K & KidsMin
Knowing when your child is ready to stay home alone is a difficult decision. Preparation can make the transition much easier for both you and your child. This 90-minute class, taught by Epic Trainings, is designed to teach children the importance of behaving responsibly when home alone. Topics include, but are not limited to, basic first aid, what to do when a stranger comes to the door, answering the phone, internet safety, and how to react during a variety of miscellaneous emergencies such as power outages and fires.
