The Day Care Lead Teacher is responsible to instruct students by taking approved curriculum goals and learning objectives and creating experiences that will contribute to the development of each student's physical, social, emotional, cognitive, and spiritual development in accordance with the center's mission.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

The essential functions include, but are not limited to the following:

- Provide active and constant supervision and daily care to all children
- Implement activities and experiences according to approved curriculum
- Ensure that all activities offered are carried out in a safe, efficient and motivating manner
- Ensure that classroom is kept clean, neat, organized and inviting to children and families
- Promote self-esteem while encouraging self-help skills
- Promote the daily exchange of information about children's activities to families
- Knowledge and compliance of all state regulations governing the operation of the center
- Interact with colleagues in supportive manner
- Ensure that child assessments and screenings are completed
- Maintain the immediate and on-going supervisory responsibilities of assistant teachers, volunteers and other non-professional personnel who may participate in the classroom.
- Other duties as assigned
