Please Take Note!

Roberts Wesleyan University has begun the multiphase process of repaving Lot A — the RWU parking lot located directly behind Pearce. The first phase of the project involves milling the lot, which removes the worn top layer of asphalt. During this stage, the surface will appear rough and textured, similar to gravel.

While the repaving project is primarily for the RWU parking lot, the university has graciously included the Pearce drop-off circle as part of the work. For the safety of anyone using the circle for drop-off or pick-up, please note that the milling process will create a difference in elevation between the driveway and the sidewalk and ramp, resulting in what may be a significant step up onto the curb or access ramp. We ask that you use extra caution when utilizing the circle drive during this time.

While the work is taking place, we ask that everyone attending Pearce for meetings, events, worship services, employment, or other activities please park in Pearce's Orchard Street parking lot, located across from the preschool playground. If additional parking is needed, overflow parking will also be available on the grassy lot adjacent to the Orchard Street lot. At this time, we are unsure how long the entire repaving process will take, but we will continue to keep you updated as the project progresses. Thank you for your patience and flexibility during this improvement project!
